- Your accomplishments:
 - ✓ Your current G.P.A. (must be a minimum of 3.0)
 - ✓ Your participation in extracurricular activities while in high school
 - ✓ Your volunteer work over the last several years
- Your educational goals following high school:
 - ✓ The college you plan to attend
 - ✓ The field or fields of study you plan to pursue
 - ✓ Your career goals
- Your financial need for the scholarship

Note: The deadline for submission of your application materials is **Friday, February 23, 2024**. Please submit all materials to your high school guidance counselor by this deadline.

- Be in your senior year of high school and preparing for college immediately following high school graduation
- Have a 3.0 cumulative G.P.A.
- Demonstrate community involvement through volunteer work
- Demonstrate participation in school-sponsored extra-curricular activities
